### 03 Make Hamilton

Make Hamilton has undergone a huge transformation in the last 3 years. What used to be the Treasury Annexe Building – a large, vacant site off Hamilton Square is now a beautiful creative hub with a thriving community, café and garden.

In 2019 we ran a crowdfunder to get initial funding to start the garden which was really well supported by the local community. Since then we have been running weekly garden volunteer sessions, including throughout the pandemic!

## 04 Current Projects

We grow a mix of annual & perennial vegetables to support the café, flowers for the bees and herbs to make teas!

#### **Bee Hives**

Our wonderful resident bee keeper John currently manages 7 bee hives situated at the bottom of the garden. They produce our "Hamilton Honey" which can be bought in the café. John also runs seasonal workshops on beekeeping and honey harvesting.





#### **Herbal Teas**



With funding from the School of Social Entrepreneurs we are creating our own herbal tea brand. We grow herbs and edible flowers in the garden, then dehydrate, package and sell them in the café.

We also run seasonal "Herbs for Health" workshops in the café/ garden where attendees learn how to create simple herbal remedies from the plants that are in season including tinctures, teas and balms.

Hops

BRIMSTAGE REWERY Make Hamilton & Callister garden are partnering with local brewery Brimstage, growing hops to create a locally grown and brewed beer (first batch set to be ready in Nov 2022). Join us in the garden to plant, grow and harvest the hops over the coming season!

# Food Waste Composting

We have community compost bays at at Make Hamilton & Make North Docks to collect food waste from our onsite cafes, residents, members and volunteers to turn into compost for the garden.

#### YES to green waste such as:

- Uncooked fruit and vegetable matter
- Tea bags, coffee grounds and filters
- Egg shells
- Cut flowers and houseplant leaves

#### YES to brown waste such as:

- Paper and cardboard: egg boxes, pizza boxes, office paper, envelopes, newspaper, chippy paper, toilet roll inners, brown cardboard – please rip big bits up to postcard size pieces, and remove any sellotape or plastic
- Wooden toothpicks, plastic-free cotton buds, cotton wool, pencil shavings
- Small twigs

#### What NOT to put in the composter:

- Cooked food and scraps from your plate
- Meat and dairy products
- Bread or pasta
- Large quantities of garden waste
- Glossy paper or card
- Cigarette butts
- Animal waste or cat litter.
- Glass, metal, plastic most of that can go in your recycling bin
